

# Free Flu Shots for Veterans

Dear Veteran:

Due to COVID-19, we encourage you to get a free flu shot at a community pharmacy or urgent care provider near you that is part of the VA network. **This replaces VA's partnership with Walgreens, which ended in March 2020.** No appointments or referrals are required to get a flu shot. To be eligible for this benefit, you must have received care from the VA or an approved community care referral in the past 24 months.

## VA In-Network Pharmacy or Urgent Care Provider Online Search

- Visit [www.va.gov/find-locations](http://www.va.gov/find-locations).
- Enter your city, state or postal code.
- Choose a Facility type and Service type:
  - In the "Facility type" box select "Community pharmacies (in VA's network)," skip the "Service type" box and click on "Search," **or**
  - In the "Facility type" box select "Urgent Care," and in the "Service type" box select "Community urgent care providers (in VA's network)" and click on "Search."
- After clicking on "Search," a listing of in-network pharmacies or urgent care providers near you will be listed.
- **Please call before going to get a flu shot to make sure your local pharmacy or urgent care provider is participating.**

When visiting a VA in-network pharmacy or urgent care provider, please let them know you are a Veteran and show them your VA Veterans Health Identification Card.

**Veterans are also encouraged to provide the following information to community pharmacies to bill VA:**

- **BIN – 004336**
- **PCN – ADV**
- **Group – RX3841**

You can also receive a flu shot during a scheduled, onsite primary or specialty care appointment throughout the VA Maryland Health Care System or during one of our drive-thru flu shot clinics, which are listed on the back of this flyer.

Free flu shots are available to all Veterans enrolled in the VA Maryland Health Care System at the locations listed.

- No appointments are necessary.
- Please bring your VA Veterans Health Identification Card.
- Turn on your hazard lights when entering the clinic driveway.
- When it is your turn, stay in your car.
- Make sure you have your mask or face covering on.
- Simply roll down the window and roll up your sleeve.

Veterans can also receive a flu shot during a scheduled, onsite primary or specialty care clinic appointment throughout the VA Maryland Health Care System or at a community pharmacy or urgent care provider that is a part of the VA network.
